

Obituary: Lewellyn Dean RAINWATER

Was born Jun 18, 1926 to Lloyd and Katherine Rainwater in Dayton, WA. He passed away on October 9, 2003 in Spokane, WA after a brief battle with cancer.

Dean graduated from Dayton High School in 1944. He went on to serve his country in World War II and the Korean War. Dean graduated from Washington State College with a Bachelors in Business Administration in 1956 and was employed in a number of jobs that brought him in touch with the public.
