DENTON, Benjamin and Elizabeth Huff. Surety, Phillip Huff. Married 3 November 1831 by William Summers. (Benjamin Denton and Phillip Huff both made their marks (X) on the Bond).

DENTON, Marion and Amanda C. Queen. Married 31 December 1858 at the house of Jeremiah Calhoun by James Wade, M.E. South. Present: Emerson Wright, J. K. Wade and others. Surety, C. Cheffield

DEWEY, Geo. T. and Henreyetta Wilder (Henrietta Wilson?). Married 30 December 1856, Ministers name missing. Grooms residence Wayne Co., age 25 years, born in New York; bride is of Monticello, age 17, born "M." County, Ohio. First marriage for both parties..

DIBRELL, Anthony and Milly Mullenix. Surety, John S. Moore. Bond dated 24 April 1811, married 26 April 1811 by Nathaniel Shrewsberry. Note: "I do expell my dauter Milly to Anthony given under my hand and seal this 15 April 1811 by William Carter - witness, Samuel Crockett".

DIBRELL, Edwin and Martha Shrewsberry. Married 28 October 1816 by Nathaniel Shrewsberry. Surety, Drury Shrewsbury.

DIBRELL, John L. and Melly Cox, Cock-Cook (?) Married 5 February 1805 by Rev. W. Shrewsberry.

DICK, Braxton C. and Anny L. Baker. Surety, William Summers. Married 5 October 1837 by Richard Barrier.

DICK, George and Evaline Wright. Surety, Valentine Wright. Married 8 September 1853 at the house of Moses Wright, by Rev. William Simpson.

DICK, George W. M. and Evaline White (see above marriage ?). Surety, A. R. White. Bond dated 1 February 1849, married 4 February 1849 by W. Hainey. (Ed. Notes: It is my opinion, that of the hundreds of notes that I read while in Monticello Courthouse, there were only several that were written outstandingly beautiful. Besides Dr. Jonathan S. Frisbie and Rev. Archibald Woods, the following 2 notes were very graceful and the only ones written in blue ink. All the others were in brown. They were written by the same person). Note: "Pulaski Co., Ky. the clerk of the Wayne County Court is hereby authorized to ishue a marriage lisons to George W. M. Duck and Evaline White yours respectfully the 31st of January 1849 by J. W. Duck". (2) "Mr Simpson you are authorized to ishue lisons to marry Evaline to George and oblidge your friend by James White - witness, F. White".

DICK, John and Elizabeth "Betsy" Chrisman. Surety, Morgan Williams. Bond dated 28 February 1806, married 3 March 1806 by North East Esq. Note: "I do consent for my daughter Betsy Chrisman to be joined in holey matrimony with John by Isaac Chrisman".

DICK, John R. and Sarah Rogers. Surety, William Simpson. Married 30 March 1836 by Richard Barrier. "Parents of Sarah, George & Elizabeth Rogers gave their consent".
