CORYELL CHURCH CEMETERY, CORYELL COUNTY, TEXAS

Take 84 East 13 miles, turn left on Farm-to-Market 185 and go four miles to the cemetery on the right side of the road. The church has a historical marker which reads: 'State Historical Survey Committee Official Historical Medallion. Coryell Baptist Church. County's first Baptist church organized June 1855 by Elders John Clabaugh and S. G. O. Bryan. Charter members were Green and Adaline Franks, Rebecca Gibson, J. G. and Sarah Ann Green, Naomi Hall, Martha Hicks, Catherine and Jesse James, Jessie and Margaret Lee James, Jessie, Margaret and Minerva McIlhaney. Congregation met for 30 years in home and school house. In 1885 erected this building. Site was donated by Green Franks and Hall. Recorded Texas Historic Landmark 1970.'
