ELDER, John Levi --died 17 Aug 1905 at his home in Oregon, Mo., aged 68. He was born in Pulaski Co., Ky., 4 Dec 1837. Came to Holt Co., Mo. with his wife & mother. He leaves his wife and 10 children-- Mrs G.C. Lewellen, of St. Joseph, Mo.; Mrs S. Judd, of Nebr.; Mrs R.D. Sipes, of Forbes, Mo.; Mrs S.R. Ford, of Forest City, Mo.; Mrs W. D. McDermont, of Mound City, Mo.; James of Oregon; Miss Mary; David & Jesse at home. Burial Maple Grove cemetery at Oregon, Mo.

ELLIOTT, Jonas Griffith --died 31 July 1904 at Lincoln, Nebr.. He was of Mound City, Mo. and was there on business. He was born near Whitesville, Cook Co., Tenn., 29 Feb 1844. He was one of a family of 15 children, 5 now living. At 16, he moved with his family to a farm near Fillmore, Andrew Co., Mo.. He married Hannah J. Cottier, 1 Feb 1870, of Holt Co.. They moved to a farm in the Minn. Valley of Holt Co., where 10 years of their married life was spent. Six children were born and 4 survive--Maggie; Francis; Paul & Gladys, with his wife, also Mrs Lulu Gilliam, the daughter of a deceased brother, who he raised from infancy. A brother Ben Elliott lives in Horton, Kan.. Burial in New Liberty cemetery, north of Mound City, Mo.

ELLIOTT, Mrs Mary Ann (nee Lowmen) --died 11 March 1905 at the home of her granddaughter, Mrs G.W. Glick, of Mound City, Mo.. Mary Ann was born in Augusta Co., Va., 10 Oct 1816. She married Samuel Elliott, 25 Dec 1840. Four boys & 3 girls were born. Six of the children and their have preceded her in death. Surviving child is, Mrs M.F. Henning, of Mound City. Mary came from Va. in 1896 and for the past 9 years has lived with her daughter. Burial in the Brethren cemetery.

ELLIOTT, Thomas --died 29 March 1905, west of Maitland, Mo.. He was born in Ross Co., Oh., 3 Jan 1826. He married Caroline Rozelle, 15 Dec 1850 and lived in the same Co. till the civil war. He enlisted in Co. B., 63rd. Ohio Vol. Inf., serving under Gen. Sherman. He moved to Mo. in 1866, to Fillmore for a year, then to Maitland. Twelve children were born and 9 are living now. A daughter is Mrs L. Medsker, of Council Bluff & Mrs Rose Riley, of King City, Mo.. Burial in the K of P cemetery.

ENSOR, Mrs R. --died 9 June 1904 in Maitland, Mo., after an illness of about 3 months. Burial in Groves cemetery in Nodaway Co., Mo.

EVANS, Lottie Leona --died 16 July 1904, of Oregon, Mo. She was the only child of Harvey & Ida Evans & was born in Oregon, Mo., 28 July 1899. Coming from a distance to the funeral were Mr & Mrs H.
