# CENTER POINT CEMETERY

THIS CEMETERY IS LOCATED ON THE GROUNDS OF THE CENTER POINT BAPTIST CHURCH. ACREAGE WAS ORIGINALLY CONTRIBUTED BY THE HENDRICKS FAMILY. SUBSEQUENT ACREAGE HAS BEEN ADDED TWICE BY THE FOLLOWING GENERATIONS OF HENDRICKS. RECENTLY, AN ADDITIONAL FIVE ACRES HAS BEEN PURCHASED, AS ADDED SPACE WAS NEEDED.

## HAZEN CEMETERY

THIS IS ONE OF THE LARGEST CEMETERIES IN PRAIRIE COUNTY. IT IS STILL ACTIVELY USED BY RESIDENTS IN THIS AREA.

ACCORDING TO NOTES BY BEATRICE BLANKENSHIP PAGE MARLAR, "ORIGINALLY THE SOUTHERN METHODIST HAD A BOXED HOUSE THEY USED OUT AT THE HAZEN CEMETERY AND THERE WERE TWO GRAVES THERE. THE FATHER AND MOTHER OF RICHARD MCCAIN". MRS. MARLAR'S FATHER BOUGHT THAT PROPERTY AND GAVE TWO ACRES FOR A CEMETERY. THEY HAD ENCLOSED ONE ACRE SO THAT MADE A TOTAL OF THREE ACRES. (EDITOR'S NOTE FROM ADDITIONAL MATERIAL: RICHARD MCCAIN EVENTUALLY MOVED TO SEARCY AND DIED JUNE 21, 1931.)

THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION IS FROM THE NOTES OF MRS. A. F. YOPP, FORMERLY RUTH ADAMS, STEP-DAUGHTER OF A. B. HUDSON, SHE RELATES:

"ON OCTOBER 11, 1873, A. B. HUDSON HAULED A LOAD OF PINE LUMBER FROM DE VALLS BLUFF TO THE SITE ON WHICH THE HAZEN CEMETERY IS NOW LOCATED, FOR THE ERECTION OF A NEW CHURCH."

"WALTER HUDSON, A CHILD AND SON OF A. B. HUDSON, WAS BURIED IN THE YARD OF THE NEW CHURCH, APRIL 14, 1874. THAT WAS THE FIRST GRAVE MADE THERE."

"ON MAY 3, 1874, A SUNDAY SCHOOL WAS ORGANIZED WITH AN ATTENDANCE OF FIFTY AND A. B. HUDSON WAS ELECTED SUPERINTENDENT. A FORMAL OPENING OF THE NEW CHURCH TOOK PLACE ON MAY 24, 1874. THIS WAS AN ALL DAY MEETING WITH DINNER ON THE GROUNDS. REV. HOLMES PREACHED WALTER HUDSON'S FUNERAL THAT DAY. THE CHURCH WAS CALLED BETHEL. WILL HAZEN WAS BIBLE TEACHER AT THE LITTLE CHURCH."

"ON JULY 8, 1874, DR. BIRKHEAD HELD A SINGING AT BETHEL. PIONEER PREACHERS AT BETHEL WERE: REV. DYCUS, A BAPTIST MINISTER, REV. BOYCE, A PRESBYTERIAN MINISTER, REV. HAWLEY, REV. JENKINS, REV. PIPKIN AND DR. WINFIELD. TRUSTEES OF THE CHURCH WERE: A. R. HAZEN, S. B. PAGE, A. B. HUDSON AND HUGH B. WHEATLEY."

"THERE WAS A UNION SUNDAY SCHOOL PICNIC ON JULY 7, 1884, AND TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY OR THREE HUNDRED PEOPLE ATTENDED. DR. A. R. WINFIELD OF LITTLE ROCK OFFERED \$170 AS AN EXTENSION GIFT. SIXTY-FIVE DOLLARS WAS THE RETURN FROM THE LUMBER OBTAINED FROM TAKING DOWN BETHEL CHURCH. THE TRUSTEES PAID \$235 PAYMENT AND ON FEBRUARY 18, 1885, PURCHASED THE NORTH METHODIST CHURCH AT HAZEN."

## MOUNT PLEASANT CEMETERY

THE AUTHOR OBTAINED A COPY OF THE ORIGINAL DEED TRANSFERRING THE LAND CONTAINING THE MT. PLEASANT/HARDSHELL CEMETERY. THE TRANSACTION IS DATED 01-27-1896. THE HEIRS OF WILLIAM HENDRICKS; R. L. HENDRICKS, A. J. HENDRICKS, B. F. HENDRICKS, MRS. S. M. DAVIS, REBECCA A. ROGERS; NAOMI McCUIN AND C. E. MOBBS, ARE LISTED HEIRS AND AMANDA HENDRICKS AND A. A. HENDRICKS ARE LISTED AS WIVES OF A. J. AND B. F. HENDRICKS, RESPECTIVELY.

THE LAND WAS ORIGINALLY DEEDED OVER TO THE PRIMITIVE BAPTIST CHURCH AT MT. PLEASANT, PRAIRIE COUNTY, ARKANSAS. THE LAND DESCRIPTION READS AS FOLLOWS: PART OF THE SOUTH EAST QUARTER OF THE SOUTH EAST QUARTER OF SECTION TWENTY-EIGHT IN TOWNSHIP THREE NORTH, RANGE SIX WEST, BEGINNING AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SAID SECTION AND RUNNING NORTH ON THE SECTION LINE FORTY RODS, THENCE TWENTY-TWO RODS WEST, THENCE FORTY RODS SOUTH, THENCE TWENTY-TWO RODS EAST, BACK TO THE SECTION CORNER, CONTAINING FIVE AND ONE-HALF ACRES MORE OR LESS.

THE ORIGINAL CHURCH BUILDING WAS BLOWN AWAY DURING A TORNADO IN 1927. IT IS ASSUMED THAT THE CHURCH RECORDS WERE ALSO DESTROYED, IF THERE WERE ANY. ALL CHURCH SERVICES WERE DISCONTINUED AND EVENTUALLY ANOTHER BUILDING, KNOWN AS THE BARRETSVILLE SCHOOLHOUSE, WAS RELOCATED ON THIS PROPERTY. EVENTUALLY CHURCH SERVICES WERE COMPLETELY ABANDONED.

TODAY (1989), THIS BUILDING IS KNOWN AS "PERRY" AND IS IN THE PROCESS OF BEING RELOCATED ON THE RAILROAD DEPOT STATION SITE IN THE CITY OF HAZEN, ARKANSAS.

I ASKED THE QUESTION OF SOME OF THE NEIGHBORS AS TO WHY THIS CEMETERY WENT BY TWO NAMES; MT. PLEASANT AND HARDSHELL. THE REPLY WAS, "THIS GROUP OF BAPTISTS WERE CLASSED AS 'HARDSHELL' BAPTISTS".
