to be a happy one.

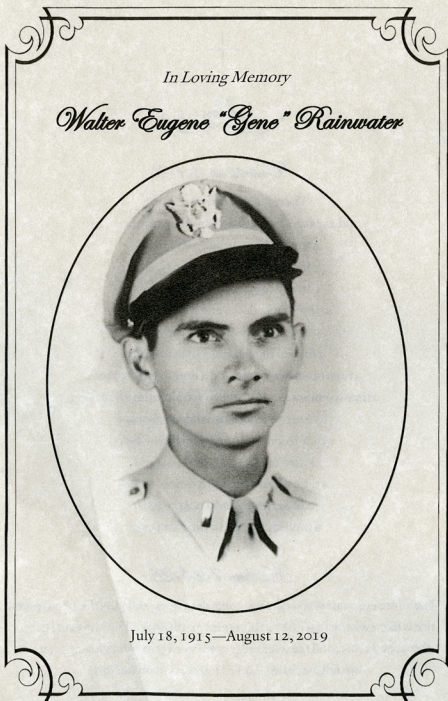
I'd like to leave an afterglow
