REGULAR RANGER Oct. 18, 1920–Apr. 30, 1921 (private, Emergency Co. No. 2, Feb. 11, 1921). Resigned. REMARKS: Had been a house carpenter in Valera, Coleman County. In June 1917 was an oil field worker in Sour Lake, Hardin County, Texas. A William Lee Lesueur died Dec. 22, 1944, Galveston County, Texas. FAMILY: Parents, James W. Lesueur (b. 1855, AR) and Lee Ella (b. 1870, AR); siblings, Earnest (b. 1891, TX), Madison "Matt" (b. 1893, TX), James Preston (b. 1895, TX), Mary A. (b. 1897, TX), Jimmie (b. 1901, TX). LEVERING, PAUL CHATTERTON. Born Mar. 31, 1874, Petersburg, Menard County, Illinois. Ht. 5 ft. 11 in., gray eyes, brown hair, fair complexion, married. Farmer, Big Wells, Dimmit County, Texas. LOYALTY RANGER June 18, 1918–Feb. 1919. Still farming in Dimmit County in 1930. A Paul C. Levering died July 29, 1953, Bexar County, Texas. FAMILY: Parents, Henry C. Levering (b. 1849, IL) and Julia Chatterton (b. 1855, IL); brothers, Roy C. (b. 1879, IL), Harry C. (b. 1886, IL); spouse, Margaret C. (b. 1882, IL), married about 1905. *SR*; *A1b*, *d*, *f*, *g*; *A2b*; *A3a*; *A4b*.

LEWIS, EDWIN P. Born June 1875, Denison, Grayson County, Texas. Ht. 5 ft. 11 in., brown eyes, dark hair, dark complexion, married. Passenger conductor, I&GN Railroad, enlisted in La Salle County, Texas. SPECIAL RANGER Aug. 8, 1916—Dec. 1917. REMARKS: Had been an employee of the I&GN Railroad from 1891—1916. In 1910 lived in Webb County, Texas. In 1920 and 1930 was a train conductor living in San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas. FAMILY: Spouse, Daisy (b. 1881, TX), married about 1903; children, Sydney (b. 1904, TX), Wilber (b. 1906, TX), Helen (b. 1909, TX), Edna (b. 1912, TX), Jack (b. 1917, TX). SR; A1e, f, g.

LEWIS, JAMES B. Born June 1869, Newport, Cocke County, Tennessee. Ht. 5 ft. 11 in., gray eyes, black hair, dark complexion, married. Lawyer, Hemphill, Sabine County, Texas. LOYALTY RANGER July 3, 1918–Feb. 1919. REMARKS: Had lived in Texas since 1880. Letterhead, 1919: "Minton & Lewis, Attorneys at Law, J. W. Minton, J. B. Lewis, Hemphill, Tex." FAMILY: Spouse, Hessie Whitehead (b. 1883, TX), married about 1908; children, Owen W. (b. 1909, TX), James B., Jr. (b. 1914, TX), Hellen M. (b. 1915, TX), Edna M. (b. 1918, TX). *SR*; *A1e*, *f*, *g*.

LEWIS, JOHN EDWARD. Born May 17, 1885, Marceline, Linn County, Missouri. Ht. 5 ft. 11 in., brown eyes, brown hair, light complexion, married. Machinist, Canadian, Hemphill County, Texas. LOYALTY RANGER July 10, 1918–Feb. 24, 1919. REMARKS: Was a machinist for the P&SF Railroad in Canadian. In 1930 was roundhouse foreman in Dalhart, Dallam County, Texas. Died Apr. 8, 1951. FAMILY: Parents, Charles Gilbert Lewis (b. 1857, MO) and Mary F. Glover; spouse, Mabel (b. 1894, TX), married about 1911. SR; A1g; A3a; A4b; B1.

LIEB, VICTOR EMANUEL. Born Mar. 17, 1883, Brenham, Washington County, Texas. Ht. 5 ft. 8 ½ in., gray eyes, brown hair, medium complexion, married. Civil engineer, McAllen, Hidalgo County, Texas. SPECIAL RANGER Aug. 4, 1919–Dec. 31, 1919. REMARKS: In Sept. 1918 was a civil engineer for the U.S. Reclamation Service living in El Paso, El Paso County, Texas. In 1930 was a petroleum geologist living in Houston, Harris County, Texas. Died Nov. 6, 1959, Harris County, Texas. FAMILY: Parents, Christian Charles Lieb (b. 1859, TX) and Mathilde Willibaldine Lehmann (b. 1862); sister, Irma Gwendolyn (b. 1891, TX); spouse, Sarah Katherine Varney (b. 1881, NY), married Oct. 25, 1911; children, Carl V. (b. 1914, TX), Betty E. (b. 1915, TX), Lewis Varney (b. 1918, TX). SR; A1b, g; A2b, e; A3a; A4b; B1.

LINCECUM, ADDISON L. Born May 1876, Long Point, Washington County, Texas. Ht. 5 ft. 9 in., brown eyes, brown hair, dark complexion, married. Physician, chief of the Texas Quarantine Service, Austin, Travis County, Texas. SPECIAL RANGER Aug. 1, 1917–June 17, 1918 (attached to Co. C). Discharged. REMARKS: Had been chief of the Texas Quarantine Service from 1914–1917. In 1920 and 1930 was a physician in general practice in El Campo, Wharton

County, Texas. An Addison L. Lincecum died Dec. 6, 1965, Lavaca County, Texas. FAMILY: Parents, Dr. Lucullas Garland Lincecum (b. 1828, MS) and Frances "Fannie" Rainwater (b. 1832, MS); siblings, John Louis (b. 1854, MS), Leander William (b. 1854, TX), Gideon (b. 1860, TX), twins James S. and John (b. 1859, TX), Ida (b. 1861, TX), Paschal B. LINDSEY, DAVID. Born 1886, Jacksboro, Jack County, Texas. Ht. 5 ft. 10 in., brownish-gray eyes, brown hair, dark complexion. Stock farmer, Jacksboro. LOYALTY RANGER July 23, 1918—Feb. 1919. REMARKS: "Acted as a substitute for short training trip with Co. C, Colorado Rough Riders." Still a stock farmer in Jack County in 1930. FAMILY: Parents, John C. Lindsey (b. 1840, TX) and Martha R. (b. 1846, KY); brother, Ray G. (b. 1883, TX); spouse, Mary E. Walters (b. 1895, TX), married about 1906; children, Dave, Jr. (b. 1922, TX), Mary L. (b. 1924, TX), John Henry Ray (b. 1926, TX). *SR*; *A1e*, *f*, *g*; *A2e*.

LINN, MARK ORA. (Listed as LINN, O. M. in Ranger Service Records.) Born Jan. or June 18, 1875, Corsicana, Navarro County, Texas. Ht. 5 ft. 11 in., blue eyes, brown hair, light complexion. Rancher, Dalhart, Dallam County, Texas. LOYALTY RANGER July 5, 1918-Feb. 1919. REMARKS: Had been a stockman in El Paso, El Paso County, Texas. In 1920 was a livestock salesman living in Phoenix, Maricopa County, Arizona. In 1930 was again a ranchman in El Paso. FAMILY: Parents, G. A. Linn (b. 1835, KY) and Amanda F. (b. 1840, AL or TX); siblings, William M. (b. 1862, TX), George P. (b. 1866, TX), Rosie B. (b. 1869, TX), Lillie G. (b. 1871, TX), Linda C. (b. 1873, TX), Dasie A. (b. 1877, TX), a brother (b. 1880, TX); spouse #1, Kate (b. 1879, TX), married about 1908; spouse #2, Imogene (b. 1892, TX), married about 1918. SR; Linn to Harley, July 30, 1918, AGC; Woodul to Linn, Aug 1, 1918, AGC; A1b, e, f, g; A3a.

LIPSCOMB, WALKER BARBEE. Born Mar. 13, 1890, Luling, Caldwell County, Texas. Tall, medium build, blue eyes, light hair. Banker, Guaranty State Bank, San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas. LOYALTY RANGER June 24, 1918–Feb.

1919. REMARKS: In 1920 was a bank clerk in Los Angeles, Los Angeles County, California. Died May 8, 1929; buried in Luling City Cemetery. FAMILY: Parents, Willoughby W. Lipscomb (b. 1850, TN or MS) and Jessie O. (b. 1867, TX); siblings, Edward P. (b. 1888, TX), Ruth (b. 1892, TX), Louis (b. 1899, TX). *SR*; 429:13; A1d, e, f; A3a.

LIPSCOMB, WILLIAM CHILDS (or CHILES). Born Aug. 12, 1860, Washington County, Texas. No physical description, married. Farmer, Brenham, Washington County. LOYALTY RANGER June 8, 1918–Feb. 1919. REMARKS: Died May 18, 1950, Brenham, Washington County, Texas; buried in Prairie Lea Cemetery. FAMILY: Parents, Abner Eddins Lipscomb (b. 1823, AL) and Mary Ann Shivers (b. 1828, AL); siblings, twins Nancy Briley and Sinai Eddins (b. 1847, AL), Jesse Shivers (b. 1849, AL), Henrietta H. (b. 1852, MS), Carrie M. (b. 1857, TX), Abner S. (b. 1863, TX); spouse, Minnie W. Weaver (b. 1869, MO), married Dec. 27, 1892; children, Susie Childs or Chiles (b. 1893, TX), Abner Eddins (b. 1897, TX). SR; A1a, d, e, f, g; A2b; A4b.

LITTLE, JAMES. Born Feb. 28, 1874, Washington County, Texas. Medium height, medium build, brown eyes, black hair, married. Stockman and farmer, Burton, Washington County. LOYALTY RANGER June 11, 1918–Feb. 1919. REMARKS: Member of the American Protective League. Letterhead in 1919: "Boone and Little, Butcher Shop and Restaurant, Dealers in All Kinds of Live Stock and Hides, Burton, Tex." In 1920 and 1930 he and his wife operated a boarding house/hotel in Washington County. FAMILY: Spouse, Mamie (b. 1884, TX), married about 1903; children, M. C. (b. 1905, TX), Grace A. (b. 1916, TX), Jimmie N. (b. 1921. TX). SR; A1f, g; A3a.

LITTLE, JOHN J. Born Aug. 1860, Kendall County, Texas. Ht. 5 ft. 10 ½ in., blue eyes, gray hair, light complexion, married. Stockman, Pearsall, Frio County, Texas. SPECIAL RANGER Sept. 24, 1918–Jan. 15, 1919. REMARKS: Frio County sheriff Nov. 8, 1904–Nov. 6, 1906. FAMILY: Parents, Brice Little (b. 1834, Scotland) and Mary Kerbny (b. 1839, Ireland); siblings, David B. (b. 1862, TX), Mary (b. 1864, TX), Samuel L. (b. 1868, TX), Sarah (b. 1870, TX), George S. (b. 1874, TX), Edmond (b. 1879, TX); spouse, Sally Blockaller (b. 1867, TX), married Dec. 31, 1895, Frio
